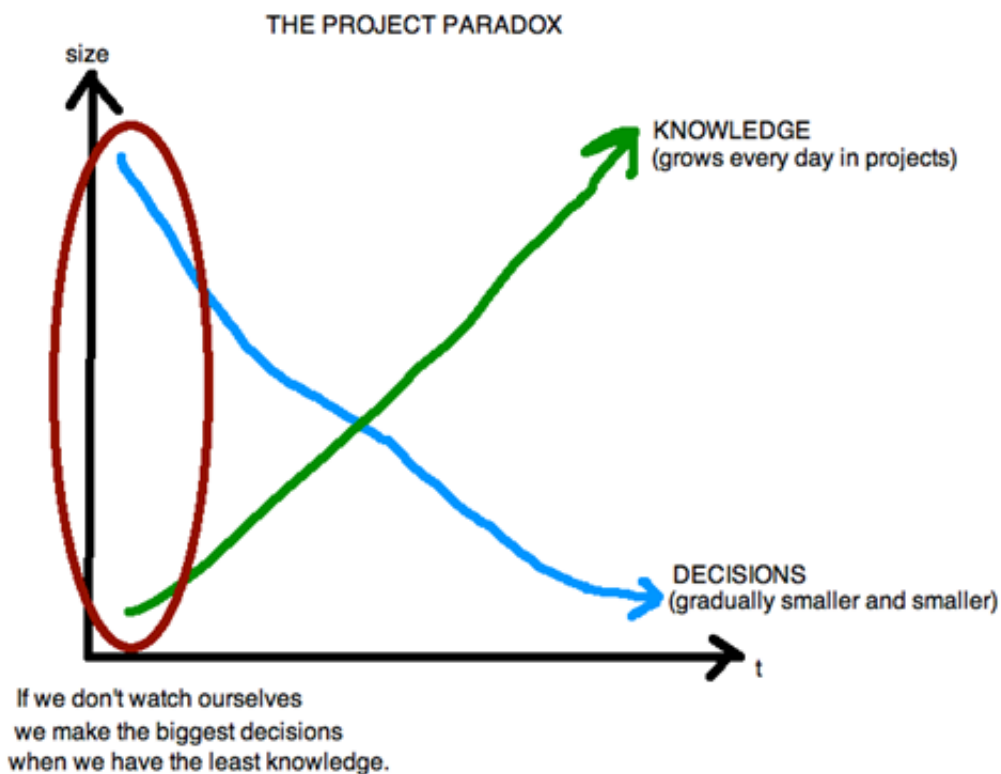

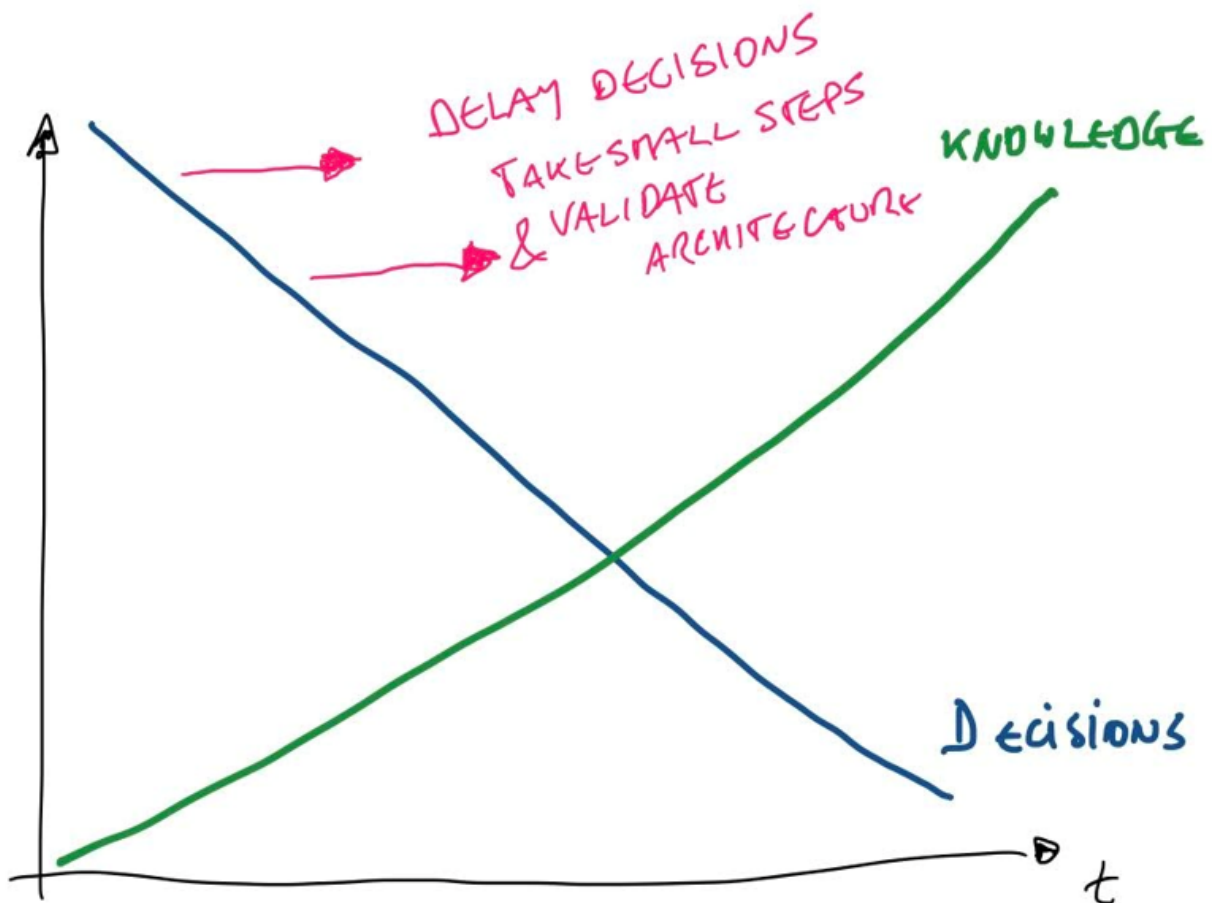

Split decisions, spike out ideas, take very small architectural steps and learn from them. Yes, this is counter-intuitive and very hard.



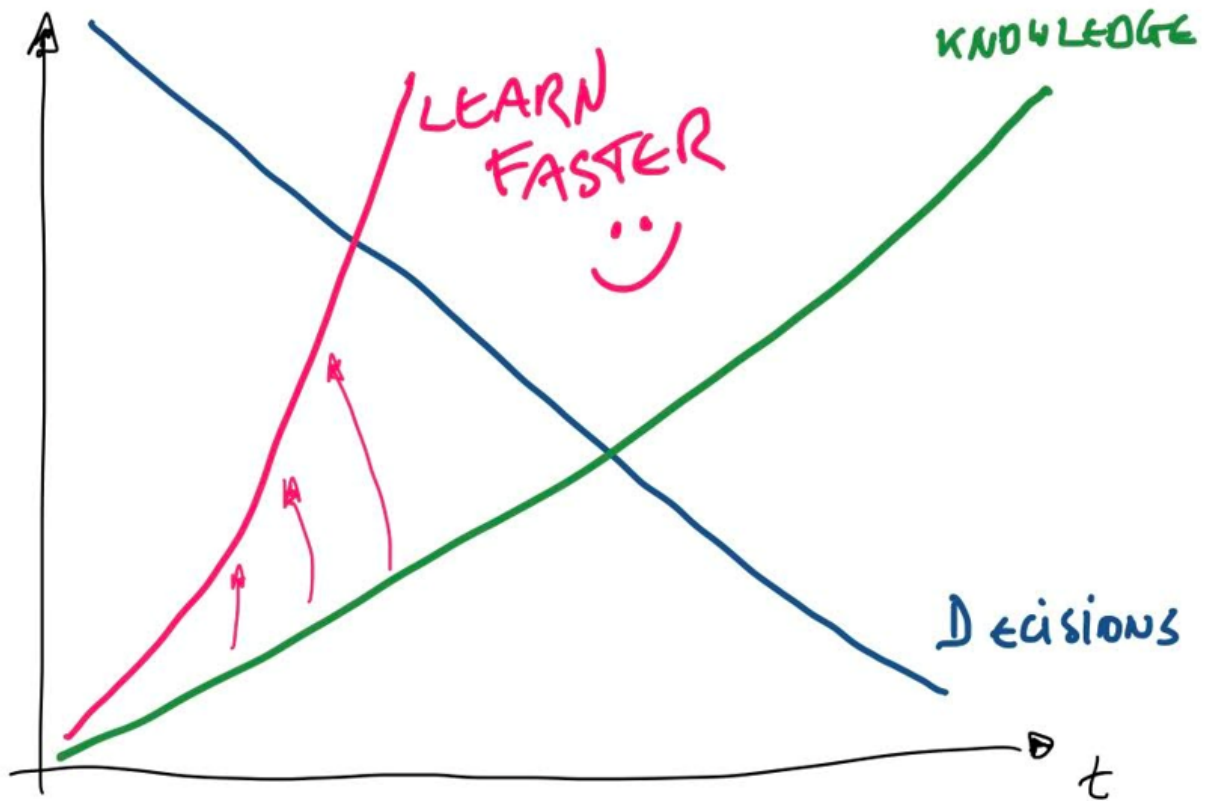
### 2nd Strategy: Learn Faster
